- 3 Reduce/stop flying. Fly with companies that are carbon aware. Use public transport.

- 4 Reduce in-person meetings, use apps like Skype, Zoom, Wherby...
- 5 Always have a reusable water bottle/coffee cup with you.
- 6 Look at the big stuff like heating and lighting - use natural light and get an energy monitor to see what you use.
- 7 Look at the small stuff - your pens, your batteries and your paper...

 - Use email only
 - Remove yourself from snail mail lists
 - Get paperless billing
 - Use cloud data

- 12 Have a local/organic lunch.
- 13 Get plants in the work space.
